The hastily put together expedition with Temple who was on the fringe of the literary scene before WWII and a close friend of the poet Siegfried Sassoon seems to have been undertaken to promote Temple's business commitments - he was a director of the Savoy Hotel. A lengthy ALS to Rich dated 8th June 1922 says..."I'll be bringing with me a fellow named Metcalfe a Captain in the Third Skinners Horse (Indian Army) who was my A.D.C. in India and who looked after my horses and ponies. I bought him home in Renown and he's got a year's leave and is going to look out for ponies and horses in England anyway until next March and he is to stay with me but all that about Metcalfe is private so please keep that information to yourself until you've seen me...it will be marvelous to get home again and I'm so excited to be less than a fortnight away after 8 long weary months though I've played 50 games of polo since I left England, did a hell of a lot of riding of all sorts in India and won

quite a lot of flat races..."
